As early as ShalimAhum (ca. 2000 B.C.), formulaic inscriptions stating 'Royale name, vice-regent of Assur built X' were written on tablets, cones, nails, prisms, cylinders and bricks, stelae, weights, door sockets, and statues made of clay and stone.
